Psychiatry

- Currently have an excellent half day release psychiatry course for those doing psychiatry post
- Previously every Thursday during 6 month attachment
- Move to 4 month training posts meant increase in number of registrars doing psychiatry post
- However decrease in duration of post meant squeezing 6 month course into 4 month course
- Also not easily accessible to those whose rotation didn't include psychiatry
