



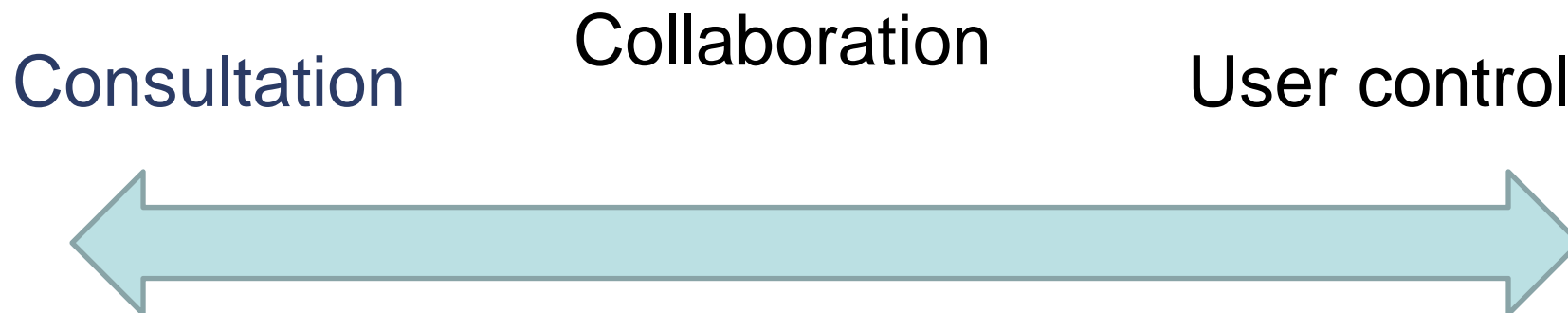
Patient and Public Involvement in Research
